Dear Parents,

As the children are coming into the classrooms so confidently now, we are going to begin lining up in the playground before school starts at 8.45am. With effect from the morning of **Tuesday 4th October**, we would like you to bring your child to their line in the playground, where we will walk into school as a class group. This system will bring us in line with the rest of the school.

We would like to remind you that if your child is going to be collected from school by anyone other than yourselves as parents, we must insist that we receive this information **in writing**. We consider the safety of your child to be of the utmost importance and so we are unable to hand over your child to anyone else unless we have written permission from yourselves to do so.

May we also request that you arrive for your child`s session promptly. It is particularly difficult to safely manage the 1pm transition if children are arriving late, as there are no extra members of staff available to supervise latecomers. It is important for the children that they feel part of the group from the very beginning of the session.

Thank you for your support in helping your child to recognise the sounds. As you will be aware, we introduce four new sounds per week and revise them on a Friday. It is really important that you practise the sounds at home EVERY DAY! Please feel free to make sound `flashcards` as this is a good way of seeing if your child can retain the sounds they are practising, without the visual cues of the pictures in the sound book. Feel free to muddle up the order in which you practise the sounds and as your child becomes more confident they might begin to have a go at blending two and then three sounds together to hear the word. Please come in and talk about any aspects of this about which you are unsure.
