Staffing News

Attendance

As the warmer weather commences, I thought it might be useful to remind parents of aspects of our attendance policy.

Request for leave during term time

Please could I remind parents that holidays cannot be authorised during term time. As stated in our Attendance Policy:

"The government's amendments make clear that Headteachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.

As stated in the regulations, Headteachers may now only grant leave in exceptional circumstances however, we do understand that a parent may need to request legitimate leave of absence for a child. We now ask that parents and carers contact the school at least two weeks prior to the requested leave dates in writing, outlining the exceptional circumstances as to why leave must be taken in term time. Should a parent/carer wish to discuss the circumstances around a leave request prior to putting it in writing, the Headteacher would be more than happy to arrange a time to meet."

Request for leave school during the school day

Where a child is required to be absent at a point during the school day, a note to the class teacher or telephone message left with the office is required. Such authorised absences might include; medical appointments, music or dance examinations (for the duration of the exam only) and open day visits to secondary schools.

All other absences during the school day, including participation in the performing arts festival (organised by the parent and not the school) require permission from the school. A request for leave must be made to the Headteacher in writing outlining the circumstances around the leave request.

Lateness

I am noticing an increased number of children who are arriving late to the school. Please could I remind all parents that the school bell rings at 8.45am, signalling the start of the school day. All children must be on the school site ready to line up with their classmates by 8.45am.

If there is a specific reason as to why your child must arrive late, please contact the school office in the first instance in order that we can ensure lunches are ordered.

Should you have any queries regarding attendance, please do not hesitate to contact the school.
