## CHRISTMAS SERVICES 2015

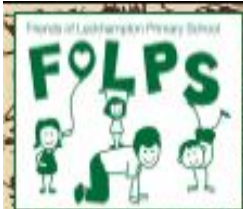
Apart from the usual Sunday Services the following will be taking place at St Peter's
