Dear Parents

Mr Seeley is also about to embark on a new initiative for the School called Safe on the Gate which you will hear more about over the coming weeks.

Do you enjoy cooking or would you like to get better at cooking?

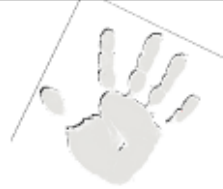
Balcarras School will be running the after school cookery courses again this year for pupils in years 5 and 6 attending specific local junior schools.

Each week you will learn new skills and have fun making something savoury or sweet to take home and share with your family. The course runs for seven weeks on Tuesday evenings from 4pm to 5.15/5.30 pm and the cost is £35.00 to include all ingredients which are supplied for you.
