Dear Parents

- Please could parents wait quietly prior to Worship and silently as the children enter the hall; this helps children to focus on the value of the term as they listen to the music chosen by the class.

ParentPay

There have been some changes to the ParentPay system and the way in which you now pay for items. This has caused some confusion and ParentPay have issued the following instructions:-

- *Select the tab you wish to make a payment for or click the Pay for Items button.*
- *Find the item you wish to pay for and select View details and pay*
- *Enter the amount that needs to be paid and select Pay now*
- *Check the details and commit by selecting Confirm payment*
- *If you have not yet topped up your account, you will likely receive an Insufficient Funds notification. Select the Top Up My Account button and either choose an amount listed or enter the amount you wish to add. Once you complete the top up, you can complete the payment and you will receive a confirmation message on screen.*

We would suggest that if you have topped up your account in the last 2 weeks it might be a good idea to check to make sure that you have allocated money in your account to outstanding items such as school trips or lunches. If you have added credit to your account without allocating then it will not show as a credit when we check our records.
