#### Parent Pay – End of School Year

As we are approaching the end of the school year a few points to remember about your ParentPay account.

- If your account is showing a deficit please make sure that this is cleared before the end of term.
- If your child is in Year 6 and the account is in credit and not likely to be used by the end of term, this can be transferred to a sibling or refunded to you. You will need to let Mrs Evans know by 14<sup>th</sup> July 2017 if this applies to you and which option you would like, thank you.
- A reminder to those entering Year 3 in September that you will have to start to pay for school lunches (unless you are entitled to Free School Meals because of personal circumstances). Please make sure that there is credit on your account in time for the first week of school if you want your child to have hot lunches, thank you.
- Any credit showing on the account of pupils currently in Years 3 – 5 will automatically be carried forward to the new school year.

#### School Visits/Music Tuition

A number of accounts are still showing an amount owing for school trips and music tuition. Please pay these amounts before the end of term or contact the school office if you are experiencing financial difficulty in meeting this.


