Stonewall School Champion

Sheffield Hallam University, Sheffield Institute of Education, Government Equalities Office, Stonewall and the Department for Education are currently working together to pilot a project aimed at supporting staff in Church Schools with tackling homophobic, biphobic and transphobic bullying.

Leckhampton has signed up for involvement in the project, which has enabled our staff to receive training on how to tackle prejudice based bullying in school and how to better support pupils. As part of the project, pupils from a specific year group and staff, were asked to complete a survey, which will be used by the Department for Education in evaluating the success of the project and provide valuable insight in to the progress being made in schools across Great Britain.

The project also requires schools to look at how we champion diversity and celebrate difference; a subject which sits perfectly alongside our school vision, values and motto. Over the coming months, we will be inviting parents in to school to further discuss how we can ensure that our school is a place where everyone is accepted, without exception.

We have been awarded *Stonewall School Champion* status for our commitment towards meeting this aim.

Your input is invaluable to us and we would welcome your thoughts and ideas on the above questions.




