Expansion of Leckhampton C of E Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that Gloucestershire County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Leckhampton C of E Primary School, Hall Road, Leckhampton, Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, GL53 0HP from 01 September 2019.

The proposal seeks approval to the expansion of the capacity at Leckhampton C of E Primary School from 420 pupils to 630 pupils by increasing the Published Admission Number from 60 to 90 for the reception intake in September 2019.

The current capacity at the school is 420 and the proposed capacity will be 630. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 439. The current admission number for the school is 60 and the proposed admission number will be 90.
