Did you know that Leckhampton is one of the special places in Cheltenham that have Community Access Defibrillators?

Yes, there is one outside the Exmouth Arms on Bath Road and one outside **Leckhampton Village Hall in Church Road.**



They are available for anyone to use when someone has a cardiac arrest.

YOU could save the life of a family member, friend, colleague, customer or complete stranger.

No training is necessary as the machine talks you through and won't shock if it is not needed.

BUT WOULD YOU HAVE THE CONFIDENCE TO ACT WHEN SOMEONE DESPERATELY NEEDED YOUR HELP?

Come along to a free Defibrillator Awareness session to be delivered by South Western Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust and learn how to do life saving first aid and use a defibrillator.

The session will be held on Tuesday, 19th February 2019 at 7.30pm at Leckhampton Village Hall, Church Road.

It will last 2 hours - 2 hours out of your life to potentially save the whole of someone else's.

Due to the size of the venue, places will be on a first come, first served basis so come in good time.

We encourage all members of the community with or without First Aid knowledge to attend this session.
