

Dear Parents

Following the announcement of the National Lockdown here is the information on our Remote Learning Plan for Year 5.

We understand that home learning presents many challenges. If at any time, you feel that the school's offer is adding to those challenges, please do get in touch with the class teacher to talk this through.

As parents will understand, whilst we are hoping to replicate our curriculum as closely as we can, some amendments and changes will be necessary.

Teachers will offer input at set times of the day and pupils will then complete work offline. Teachers will be clear about which work must be uploaded for feedback and will guide the children through each day.

As the children will be attending Virtual School we would like them to wear school uniform. You may find it useful to designate an area for Virtual School and, if possible, for this to be at a table.

Microsoft Teams will be used for virtual lessons and pupils will receive their log on details today.

The daily plan is as follows – each year group has their own timetable to try and accommodate families where children need to share devices:

9.00am **Pupils log on for registration and welcome. This will be followed by a short Maths or English input.**

Pupils will then log off and complete work set by the teacher. If required, pupils submit work at 10am. The teacher will make it clear as to which work needs to be submitted.

10.00am **Pupils log on for Maths or English input.**

Pupils will then log off and complete work set by the teacher. If required, pupils submit work at 11am. The teacher will make it clear as to which work needs to be submitted.

11.00am **Pupils log on for a recap of the morning and teachers offer feedback on work submitted.**

12.00 - 1.00 lunch

1.40pm **Pupils log on for input for afternoon session.**

Pupils log off and complete work set by teacher. Pupils submit any work requested by 3.00pm.

We do understand how hard it can be to juggle family, work and home learning. If you experience any difficulties in completing the work, please do get in touch and we will do our very best to help.

The teachers are ready to welcome Year 5 to their virtual lessons tomorrow morning!
