



Dear Parents,

It has been a very busy and productive first week back after the half-term break. The children have settled straight back in to their learning and we have seen great effort and perseverance across the school. Please find below details of upcoming events:

Transition arrangements

As we approach the final weeks of the academic year, we would like to provide further information about the transition arrangements to help the children prepare for the next stage of their education. We also plan to write to parents next week to confirm each child's new class teacher for September.

Tuesday 20th June & Wednesday 21st June

Our new Reception pupils will be joining us on these days so our **current Reception pupils will spend two full days in Year 1**. They should arrive at school at the usual time and through the normal entrance but, once registered, they will move over to the KS1 classrooms to spend two full days with their new teachers. They will then be dismissed at the normal time from the hall doors. We feel that this enhanced transition from EYFS to KS1 will benefit the pupils greatly.

On these days, the current Year 1 and Year 2 pupils will be doing some team-building activities and woodland activities to allow the KS1 classrooms to be used. More information will be added next week on Class Dojo about clothing needed for these days.

Thursday 13th July 9.30am – 11.45am

On this morning, **every year group will move up to spend the morning with their new teacher**. This will be followed by the **Informal Open Evening from 4pm until 5.15pm** where parents are invited to drop in to meet their child's new teacher and have an informal chat with current teachers.

During July, our Year 6 pupils will be taking part in their transition days at their new schools and we look forward to hearing about their experiences in Year 7.

On Friday 23rd June, we will be holding the final Open Classrooms of the academic year. This will run at the usual time of 8.35am to 9am.
