

# Dear Parents

Firstly, we would like to give a warm welcome to the families that have joined our school family this term. There has been a wonderful feeling around the school over the last two weeks and we have seen so many acts of kindness from children already as they help their younger peers settle in.

### General Points and Safety Notices

We should like to remind parents of some practical aspects of School life which will help to keep everyone safe and happy.

#### Parents on School Site

In the interests of security, parents wishing to come onto the School site must report to the School Office.

Parents whose children are "late" for School or wish to take their child to an appointment (having previously told the class teacher) must report to the office staff who will ask parents to record their child's entrance/exit from the School premises.

Most importantly, only bona-fide visitors and parents wearing a badge are allowed in the School building during School hours. Staff will challenge anyone not wearing a badge on the School site. The only exception will be when teachers invite parents into their classroom to discuss their child's welfare.

#### **General Matters**

Please could we ask adults and children to walk on the tarmac footpath keeping to the left hand side when on school site. Please do not walk on the grass to reach the playground. Children must not swing on the School metal gate or School fences for their own safety.

Please could we remind parents that in the interests of our children's safety, cars should not be driven on the pavement, parked on yellow lines or block neighbours' entrances. Traffic Wardens have recently reported their concerns about illegal parking around Schools and will be making random checks.

Please be reminded that no dogs should be on-site (unless they are an Assistance Dog).

Please ensure that your child is closely supervised at the end of the School day.

#### Children's belongings

The school site is looking tidy and organised and we are hoping to keep it this way. There will be times when children misplace their belongings but, as long as they are clearly labelled, staff will return items to children as soon as possible. Some unnamed items are placed in our Lost Property unit

which is behind Year 1, please do check there for any misplaced items. Unfortunately, at the end of each half-term the items not claimed will be placed in a clothing bank.

We should like to thank you in anticipation of your support in these matters. Due to the large number of pupils we have on roll, it is essential that we work together to ensure the safety of our children and to support the smooth running of the school.

Please could we remind parents that your ParentPay account must be in credit prior to your child ordering a school meal. If there is a genuine error, please contact the school office.
