Class Worships

Reception Welcome Service

On Wednesday, our Reception pupils visited St. Peter's Church for their Welcome Service. The children listened well to Reverend Gary and our Year 6 Choir sang a wonderful rendition of Chosen Family.

Each Reception pupil received a Talk- Time-Bag. This is a special bag that contains three stones for the pupils to use at home to reflect on their days:

Ordinary Stone – Now Moments When children take this stone out of the bag, they reflect on the present moment and take a moment to appreciate something such as a ray of sunshine.

Sharp stone – Ow Moment

When children take this stone out of the bag, they reflect on a difficult moment or something that made them feel sad.

Shiny Stone – Wow Moment

When children take this stone out of the bag, they reflect on a special or exciting moment that they have experienced.

House Captains, Sports Captains and Art Captains

Each year, pupils in Year 6 are invited to apply to be a Captain for their house. During the application process, the children demonstrate how they would promote our school vision and values. Elections have now taken place and badges have been awarded to our new House Captains, Sports Captains and Arts Captains.
